



What will the ePublisher demo show me?

This demo will show you how ePublisher can be used to quickly and easily produce high quality output and conformance reports from one or more source documents.

What software is provided as part of the demo?

Your initial demo includes a version of the "Non-Designer" package of the ePublisher Platform, which contains the component called "ePublisher Express". It installs on your desktop computer and once activated allows you to begin publishing your own documents originating from any of: Microsoft Word, Adobe FrameMaker, and DITA.

You may submit a special request to evaluate the "Designer" component called ePublisher Pro by contacting your sales representative. With ePublisher Pro, you can customize the publishing configuration to your specific styling and format requirements.

What can I do with the software?

You can use the included "Stationery" developed by the WebWorks.com team (or your own stationary created in Pro) to publish up to eight different documents of any supported input format into one of these output formats: "WebWorks Help", "HTML Help", or "Dynamic HTML".

What are the supported Input formats?

The ePublisher platform supports the following input formats: Adobe FrameMaker 7.2 to 9.0, Microsoft Word XP to 2007, Valid DITA created from any XML editor.

What output formats can ePublisher generate?

PDF, WinHelp, Java Help, HTML Help, Eclipse Help, XHTML, Confluence, MediaWiki, MoinMoin, HTML 3.2, Custom XML, Active Web Pages, iPhone, Palm and Microsoft Reader. Full Accessibility and 508 Compliance

After requesting a Free Trial, what's the next step?

You will be sent an email with a link to download the demo software. In addition, you will receive a "Contract ID" or activation code that will activate the demo functionality for 15 days.

What other ePublisher components are available?

When you adopt ePublisher, you will want to create your own "Stationery" based on your own branding and publishing requirements. To create this "Stationery" you will need at least one seat of the "Designer" package of the ePublisher Platform.

The "Designer" package is for one person and includes the Express and Pro components. Express is used for day to day publishing, and Pro is used to design and maintain your Stationery.

Automatic/Scheduled Conversion

When you adopt ePublisher, you may also want to consider the "AutoMap Server" package of the ePublisher Platform. This package provides the component called AutoMap, which can be installed on a single machine and can be used by one or more users for scheduling conversions to occur automatically and/or as part of a larger scripted solution.
